

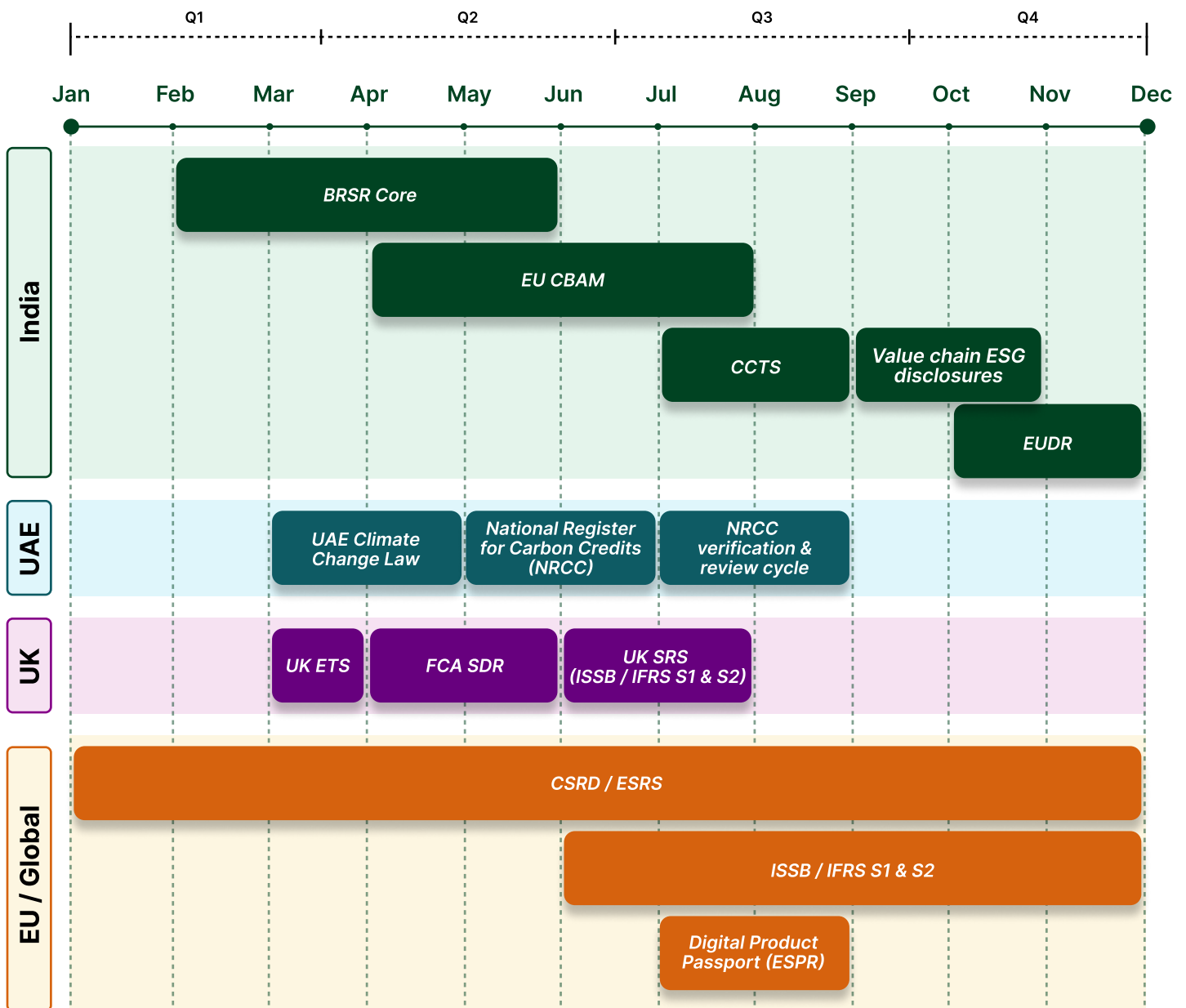

BRSR Core Assessment / Assurance	BRSR Core moves from disclosure-only to formal assessment or assurance.	Large listed companies across sectors	ESG data must be traceable, consistent, and audit-ready
EU CBAM Impact on Indian Exporters	CBAM enters its definitive phase, linking embedded emissions to trade costs	Exporters of cement, aluminium, iron & steel, fertilisers	Emissions intensity affects pricing and EU market access
Indian Carbon Market Carbon Credit Trading Scheme (CCTS)	Operationalisation begins, focusing on emissions baselines and MRV systems	Power, cement, iron & steel, fertilisers, refining	2026 is a readiness year before compliance obligations tighten
Value Chain ESG Disclosures	SEBI formalises expectations on supplier-level ESG data and boundary definition	Manufacturers and consumer companies with large supplier bases	Supplier data gaps are now a regulatory risk
EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR)	From December 2026, products placed on the EU market must be deforestation-free	Exporters linked to coffee, cocoa, rubber, palm oil, soy etc.	Non-compliance can block EU supply chains

UK Emissions Trading Scheme (UK ETS)	2026 is a standalone compliance year with annual surrender obligations	Carbon pricing directly impacts operating costs
FCA Sustainability Disclosure Requirements (SDR)	Active enforcement of sustainability disclosures and anti-greenwashing rules	Misaligned claims attract regulatory scrutiny
UK SRS (ISSB / IFRS S1 & S2)	Sustainability and climate disclosures are integrated into financial reporting	Sustainability data must meet financial-grade governance and controls

CSRD / ESRS	CSRD enters scale-up mode, with more companies reporting and assurance expectations hardening	EU sustainability reporting becomes comparable, assured, and decision-grade
ISSB / IFRS S1 & S2	Multiple jurisdictions adopt ISSB standards, embedding sustainability into mainstream financial disclosures	Climate and sustainability data must align with financial reporting rigor
Digital Product Passport (ESPR)	Product-level lifecycle and traceability data requirements are phased in	Data systems - not PDFs - become the basis for EU market access

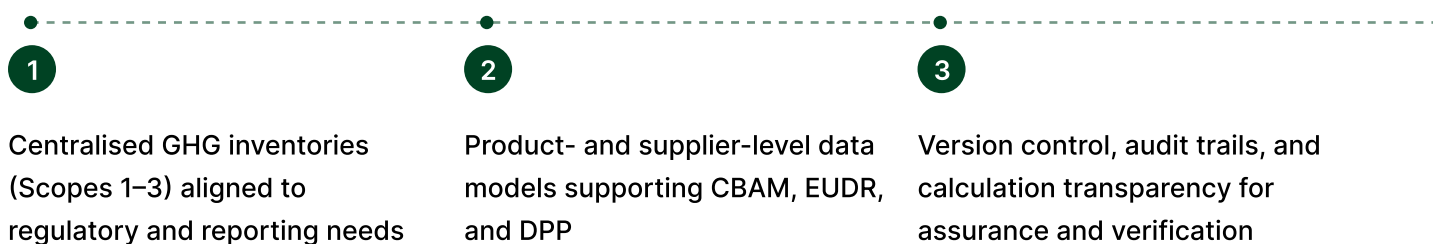

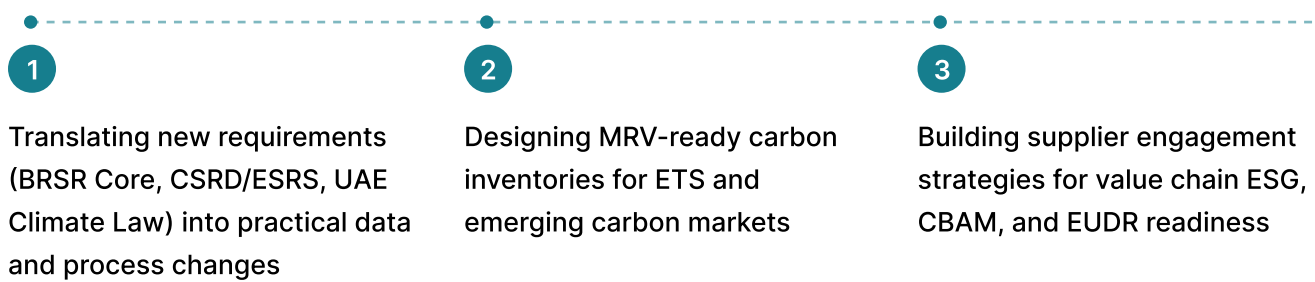

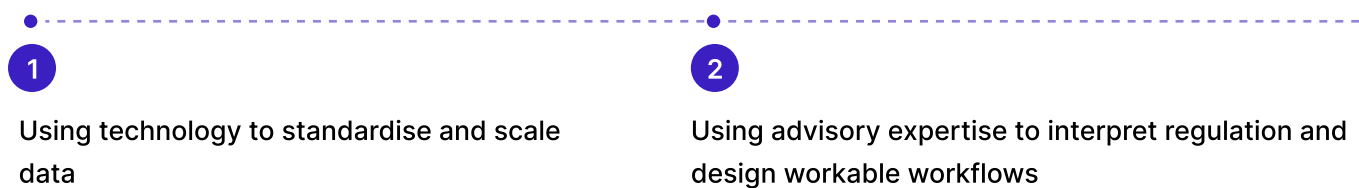
